

Ethnicity V. Religion

 Ethnicity: includes religion, location, beliefs, traditions, race

Religion is a specific set of beliefs



North Africa



- Egypt, Libya,
 Algeria, Morocco
- Arabs are the main ethnic group
 - Speak Arabic
 - United by culture, religion and language
 - Mostly followers of Islam

Eastern Mediterranean




- Syria, Jordan,

Israelis




- -In Israel

 for the past 70 years.


The Northeast (Iran, Iraq & Turkey)



Turks

- Speak the Turkish language
- Live in Turkey
- Mostly followers of Islam
- Iranians
 - Speak Farsi
 - Live in Iran
 - Mostly Shia branch of Islam
 - Sometimes calledPersians

The Northeast (Iran, Iraq & Turkey)



Arabs

- Mostly live in Iraq in the Northeast
- Most are Shia Muslims, and
 35% are Sunni Muslims
- Speak Arabic

Kurds

- Do not have a country of their own, instead they are spread throughout the region
- Most are Sunni Muslims
- Speak Kurdish

The Arabian Peninsula (Saudi Arabia, Yemen, Oman, United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Kuwait, Kuwait, Bahrain)

- Most people are Arabs
- Most speak Arabic
- Many governments follow Sharia Law, or Islamic Law, limiting many freedoms of the people who live there.
- Most are followers of Islam.



Central Asia (Afghanistan, Georgia, Armenia, ...)



- Ethnic diversity
- Most speak a form of the Turkic language or Russian
- In Armenia, most people are Christian but the majority of people in the region are Muslim
